- Grand opening: December 16, 2009
- Solidifying CityCenter's commitment to sustainability, [ARIA Resort & Casino](#) is one of the first Las Vegas hotels to achieve LEED® Gold certification by the U.S. Green Building Council. ARIA is currently the largest hotel in the world with LEED Gold status.
- ARIA is currently accepting reservations for December 17, 2009 and beyond; concierge service and reservations for spa, salon and restaurants will be available beginning in November
- The spectacular gaming resort is located at [CityCenter](#), an unprecedented urban metropolis opening in December 2009 on the Las Vegas Strip
- In addition to ARIA, CityCenter will include three luxurious non-gaming hotels including [Vdara Hotel & Spa](#), [Mandarin Oriental, Las Vegas](#) and The Harmon Hotel (opening late 2010); [Veer Towers](#), the development's only strictly residential buildings; [Crystals](#), a 500,000-square-foot retail and entertainment district; and an unparalleled [Fine Art Collection](#). Vdara, Mandarin Oriental, Las Vegas and Veer Towers will include approximately 2,400 residences total

Technology

Upon opening, ARIA will feature the most [technologically advanced guestrooms](#) in the country. ARIA will deliver to every guestroom a level of personalized automation currently found only in high-end custom homes. Guestrooms will be networked with fiber offering one gigabit of bandwidth for matchless Internet connectivity and guest service:

- Rooms recognize guests' first time in the room and "greet" them as they enter; light fills the room, curtains part to show the view, TV turns on to display list of automated controls for guests to personalize
- Preferences remembered every time guest is in-room
- One-touch control of lighting, room temperature, television/video systems, music, wake-up calls, draperies and requests for services through a single, easy-to-use remote control
- Guests can wake up gradually through controlled temperature, lighting, curtain opening and preferred music
- One button can modify all room settings at once. "Good Night" turns off lights, TV and/or music; shuts curtains; and turns on privacy notification
- Keyless locks utilizing RFID technology reduce the failure of rooms keys
- Wireless Internet up to eight times faster (128 kilobytes) than today's average U.S. hotel
- In-room devices automatically "communicate" maintenance needs; remote control batteries will be replaced before guests notice a problem, and more

Dining

- [Bar Masa](#) – Making his Las Vegas debut, Chef Masayoshi Takayama's concept will comprise two distinct dining experiences. The restaurant's casual dining space will feature an à la carte menu of modern Japanese cuisine. Shaboo, an intimate and exclusive venue within Bar Masa, will have an ever-changing menu based on the best seasonally available ingredients. Each table will feature its own induction cooking element to create the ultimate dining experience. The restaurant, designed in collaboration with Richard Bloch, will be refined and sleek, yet awe-inspiring with ceilings that soar to 35 feet
- [Sage](#) – For his first restaurant outside of Chicago, Chef Shawn McClain – named "Best Chef Midwest" by the James Beard Foundation – will spotlight farm-to-table produce, artisanal meats and sustainable seafood. Designed by Jacques Garcia Decoration, the restaurant will envelop guests in a sophisticated yet comfortable atmosphere
- [AMERICAN FISH](#) – For his newest concept, James Beard award-winner Chef Michael Mina will draw inspiration from the bounty of American lakes, rivers and coasts to create a menu featuring refined American cuisine. Many products will be purchased directly from fishermen, farmers and ranchers allowing diners to enjoy unique regional dishes. The menu also will feature a wide array of well-sourced meats. Chris Sheffield of SLDesign, LLC, in collaboration with Mina, designed a room that resembles a traditional lodge, with masculine touches such as warm woods and leather accents

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- [Julian Serrano](#) – The internationally acclaimed chef’s eponymous restaurant will feature a casual atmosphere with menus at different price points. The expansive seafood bar will highlight fresh shellfish and ceviches, while the dining room and lounge will serve tapas and other dishes from Serrano’s native Spain
- [Jean-Georges Steakhouse](#) – At ARIA, Chef Jean-Georges Vongerichten will eschew tradition by melding beloved steakhouse touches with a decidedly contemporary experience. The menu will highlight the best ingredients and preparations, paying particular attention to an innovative array of side dishes and sauces. Designed by Dupoux Design, the restaurant’s high-octane lounge and extensive bar program will focus on classic cocktails
- [Sirio](#) – Chef Sirio Maccioni will introduce a menu of Italian favorites such as Veal Milanese, Osso Buco and authentic pasta dishes. Guests will enjoy traditional cocktails of Italy and one of Las Vegas’ largest selections of Italian vintages at a wide array of price points. Designed by longtime Maccioni collaborator Adam Tihany, Sirio will channel old-time Italy with its fantastical, Fellini-esque décor

- [JP Pâtisserie](#) – Chef Jean-Philippe Maury will bring his signature chocolates to ARIA at JP Pâtisserie. Designed by Norwood Oliver Design Associates, the concept will feature his irresistible desserts alongside breakfast pastries, sandwiches, crêpes, salads and paninis

- [Lemongrass](#) – A modern Thai restaurant, designed by James Beard Award winner AvroKo

- In ARIA’s reception area, world-renowned artist Maya Lin will create her first work of art in Las Vegas, *Silver River*, an 84-foot silver cast of the Colorado River. Lin is using reclaimed silver in the spirit of CityCenter’s commitment to sustainability and in light of Nevada’s standing as the “Silver State”

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- In the resort's north valet, Jenny Holzer will display one of her impactful LED signs, spanning more than 250 feet
- Three stainless steel sculptures by Tony Cragg also will be featured at ARIA: *Bolt*, 2007, will swirl upward from its narrow base in an imaginative bolt of lightning; *Bent of Mind*, 2008, will give the illusion of an elegant silhouette of a face, as do many of his other works; and *Untitled* (tall column), 2008, will be presented in a graceful, curving form.

Meetings & Convention Facilities

- Four ballrooms will offer the flexibility to accommodate gatherings of all sizes from 10 to 5,000 attendees
- Three ballrooms will feature fully functioning theatrical stages
- The facility will encompass three levels and deliver 38 meeting rooms ranging from 800 to 2,000 square feet
- The north façade will feature a spectacular glass curtain wall overlooking ARIA's beautiful pool deck , providing a lush, landscaped backdrop and the warmth of natural light

Nightlife (ages 21 and older)

- Nine bars and lounges
- Haze Nightclub will be a colossal cutting-edge space in which guests will be challenged to question their sense of perception and reality. Designed by award-winning interior design firm, ICRAVE, the nightclub will feature large hanging props over the entryway that will draw guests to a grand staircase transporting them to the mezzanine level where they will enjoy a bird's-eye view of the action below. The main dance floor will peer up at a wall of interactive projection screens stretching one hundred feet across on a performance structure where impromptu acts by world-renowned artists will regularly take place.

Crystals at CityCenter

- Just outside ARIA, Crystals, CityCenter's retail and entertainment district, will house more than 500,000 square feet of sophisticated retail and dining. Designed by Studio Daniel Libeskind* with interior architecture by David Rockwell, Crystals will combine dramatic architecture with exclusive offerings from the world's most elite brands to become a preeminent shopping destination.
- Large-format luxury retailers Louis Vuitton, Hermes, Prada, Christian Dior, Bulgari, Van Cleef & Arpels, TIFFANY & CO., Mikimoto and Ermenegildo Zegna will be among the exceptional brands presented under Crystals' multi-faceted canopy of unprecedented brilliance. Unique-to-the-market retailers opening their first locations in Las Vegas include Tom Ford, Assouline, Kiton, Miu Miu, Paul Smith, Porsche Design, de Grisogono, H. Stern, Marni and Tourbillon.
- Restaurants opening their first Las Vegas locations at Crystals include Eva Longoria Parker's BESO and Mastro's Ocean Club, joining an exciting new pub concept by Todd English. Wolfgang Puck will open two innovative new restaurant concepts, including a contemporary interpretation of a traditional French brasserie with tastes of the Mediterranean region.
- Many more luxury brands and dining concepts will be announced at a later date.

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Sustainability at CityCenter

- Upon opening, CityCenter will be one of the largest sustainable developments in existence, bringing a new level of environmental consciousness to the world-famous Strip. The U.S. Green Building Council has awarded LEED Gold certification to ARIA's hotel tower, convention center and theater; as well as Vdara. CityCenter's remaining venues are poised to receive a combination of Silver and Gold LEED ratings.
- ARIA will feature the world's first fleet of stretch limos powered by compressed natural gas (CNG). In addition to abundant domestic reserves, CNG is one of the cleanest-burning alternative fuels available.
- ARIA's design incorporates sustainable features including the extensive use of natural light, dramatically reducing lighting power requirements in guestrooms, and water-saving fixtures throughout.
- The resort is designed to achieve more than 30 percent improvement in energy efficiency.
- ARIA will save an estimated 31 million gallons of water each year. This equates to an overall savings of 34 percent within the building and 60 percent in outdoor landscaping over existing building codes.
- ARIA will offer sustainable options for meetings, conventions and events by incorporating environmentally responsible practices and services. In addition, all convention sales kits will be made from recycled paper materials with the exception of the outside wrap, and the uniforms in the convention area will be woven from recycled polyester.
- Once in operation, ARIA will utilize two recycling docks for collection and separation of glass, paper, cardboard, metals, plastic, food waste and grease.
